

## Attributes and Colors and How To Interpret Them As They Apply to the Message from Your Higher Self

During the Closing Ceremony you will receive two special gifts from the Divine: one is a card with a “word of wisdom,” and the other is a color.

To determine how the word enhances the message from your Higher Self about how best to utilize the qualities you've identified this week to build a new world from the inside out, you might ask yourself, *what does this word bring to mind?* Exploring those possibilities will offer valuable insights.

**Violet** is a color of receptivity and relates to lining up energies on the spiritual levels before taking action. It is associated with the seventh chakra, the third eye and the pituitary gland. Cayce notes that this center is often “lukewarm,” meaning it is little used. It is enlivened by passion and enthusiasm.



**Indigo** (dark sapphire blue) is a color of deep receptivity. It relates to meditation, and to lining up energies on the spiritual levels before taking action. It is associated with the sixth chakra, the crown chakra and the pineal gland. According to Cayce it is the “mount of God.”



**Blue** (medium aqua blue) is a color of receptivity. It relates to heaven, spirit, contemplation and prayer, and to lining up energies on the spiritual levels before taking action. Blue is dedicated to social service, the arts and the sciences. It is associated with the fifth, throat chakra/thyroid gland, and to the voice, including the inner voice.



**Green** is the color of balance and healing. It occupies the center position of the seven chakras, like a fulcrum. It relates to the fertility of a verdant Spring and is associated with the heart chakra/thymus gland, and also with friendliness, compassion and love.



**Yellow** is a color of activity, especially mental activity. It connotes wellbeing, positive mental attitude, and a “sunny disposition.” It is associated with the third chakra; the adrenal glands and solar plexus.



**Orange** is a color of physical activity. It is often associated with thoughtfulness, consideration, peacemaking and creativity, since it joins the physically-focused activity of red with mental activity of yellow. It is associated with the cells of Leydig, and the second/navel chakra.

**Red** is a color of physical activity, focused forward motion, and especially energetic physical activity. It relates to life force and vigor. It is associated with the root chakra/gonads.
